How to Redeem a Property from Tax Sale By 9/15/2024

- 1. Contact the Bureau of Revenue Collections at 410-396-3987
 - Ask how much money is owed to redeem the property
 - Ask how long before that amount increases

2. Once you have the above information, you should acquire a certified bank check or money order in that amount made out to "**Director of Finance**".

- Be sure the notation on payment says "for tax sale redemption 2024"
- Take a photograph of the certified bank check or money order for your records!

3. Once you have the payment ready, it would be best to submit it in person at the **Abel Wolman Building** cashiers (on the first floor).

- Make sure you tell the teller that the payment is intended for tax sale liens and that you want to redeem the property from this year's tax sale
- <u>Get and keep the receipt for your records!</u>

Abel Wolman Building is located at 200 Holliday St, Baltimore, MD 21202, next to City Hall.

The last day to redeem a property using the above process is 9/15/2024!!

How to Redeem a Property from Tax Sale After 9/15/2024

To redeem a property after 9/15/2024 please know that a 2-step process is involved; you must first pay the lien cert holder fees and interest and then pay the Bureau of Revenue Collections.

- 1. Contact the lien purchaser and ask how much money is owed
 - If you haven't been contacted with the address and contact info of the lien certificate holder, please contact the Bureau of Revenue Collections at 410-396-3987
- 2. Once you have that information, pay the lien purchaser in whichever method they require in order to receive a release from them.
 - The release is generally good for 10 business days
- 3. Before the release expires contact the Bureau of Revenue Collections to arrange for payment
 - When making payments to the Bureau of Revenue Collections, be sure to photograph the certified bank check or money order and keep the receipt for your records!
