

### Sixth Substantial Amendment Revising the Baltimore City 2019 Program Year Annual Action Plan for CDBG-CV1 and CV3 Funded Activities

In late March 2020, the federal government enacted the Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security (CARES) Act. Included in the CARES Act were two rounds of funding for the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) program. Baltimore City was awarded \$13,101,766 in CDBG-CV1 funds (Round 1), and \$3,325,357 in CDBG-CV-3 funds (Round 2).

Substantial amendments in May and December of 2020 and July of 2022 identified activities to be supported with CDBG-CV1 and CDBG-CV3 funds. A substantial amendment in April 2023 re-allocated unused CDBG-CV1 funds to provide additional funding to an existing activity. A substantial amendment in February 2024 changed program guidance to reach a greater number of persons in need and provide for faster spenddown of CV-1 and CV-3 funding.
